The Pediatric Integrated BH Clinician (PIC) is an integral member of the patient's care team, promoting positive child development, behavioral health, and family resilience through the provision of education and therapeutic services. The PIC supports screenings and provides comprehensive assessments and behavioral healthcare to families in primary care through the use of a team approach. They are embedded into Primary care teams, sharing patient panels and supporting robust screening and treatment for the care team's entire patient population. The PIC works in concert with a Family Partner, and collaborates across primary care teams with a corps of Family Partners and PICs. The PIC plays a key role in Behavioral Health Integration and Patient-Centered Medical Home initiatives.
