A Partnership of the Codman Square Health Center & Codman Academy Charter Public School

The Codman Square Health Center (CSHC) has been awarded a \$7.95 million dollar Capital Development Program Grant from the Health Resources and Services Administration. The funding will be used to build a 34,000 square foot green expansion to the Health Center's main building. Space will allow the Health Center to expand clinical programs, and also add space for educational and social programs.

- 22 new exam rooms allowing for 5,300 new patients and 22,526 additional (+21%) patient visits

- 3 new rooms to be used for group medical visits, including the Health Center's pregnancy and parenting programs

11,538 SQ FT OF EXCLUSIVE USE

SPACE TO INCLUDE:

- 10 classrooms including 2 science labs and a science/art room
- 2 student break-out spaces
- A library
- Faculty work and storage space
- Student/alumni meeting space
- Outdoor "green" teaching space

PLUS

10,635 SQ FT OF SHARED

SPACE TO INCLUDE:

- Dining facility with space for a teaching kitchen facility
- Black box theatre
- Seminar and meeting rooms
- Roof and healing gardens

As the only school in the nation located inside a community health center, all students complete internships applying math and science to public health issues and careers.

In November 2010, Codman Square Health Center was awarded Boston's first Mayoral Prize for Health Care Innovation in recognition of its vision of combining health care and education to address poverty, which includes the internship program with Codman Academy and the health and wellness programs offered in partnership with Codman Academy.
