BMC HEALTHNET

If you have BMC HealthNet ACO insurance, you are eligible for 1 **car seat** per child up to 65lbs, which you can request by calling member services at (888) 566-0010.

MassHealth BMC HealthNet insurance also provides a delivery of around 200 **free diapers** to families who attended a postpartum visit 12 weeks or less following delivery. Ask your pediatrician to be referred to this program.

WELCOME BABY

Welcome Baby provides a **celebratory home visit and gift bag** to families with newborns. Welcome Baby visitors share information about activities, resources, and services in the community.
